I. 20 marks

a. Classical literature: is a literary genre invented by the Greeks in the 5th century Bc. It told the story of a hero and his subsequent downfall. The hero is usually a person that occupies a high position but who has a fatal flaw that causes his downfall.

Themes expressed: honor and Pride as the driving forces in The Iliad. 2- the horror of war.

The importance of the passage in the plot: This passage is very important because it changes the tide of war to the benefit of the Trojans as Achilles, the greatest warrior, withdraws from fighting.

The speaker: Teiresias
