## The past simple +the past perfect

The past perfect (had + the past participle) is used to show which of the two actions happened first .Often the other verb in the sentence is in the simple past.

ex: I had locked the door before I went to bed.

*we can use different words to link the two actions :
1-By the time:
ex: I had already cooked the dinner by the time my mother came 0
ex: By the time she was 21, she had got married.
2-When:
ex: When we arrived at the theater, the concert had already started
ex: when I arrived at the restaurant, my friends had left.
3- Before:
ex: Carol had learnt to speak three languages before she when to school.
ex: Sami watched a film before he had gone to sleep.
4-After:
ex: After the lesson had ended, I spoke to the teacher.
5- Until:
Ex: They had never learnt English until they came to this school
6- Because:
Ex: He looked so different, because he had grown a moustache.
