السؤال الثالث : (25 + 25)

Compare between Greek and Roman tragedy

- Greek Drama was merely religious, interested in the relation between men and gods. It was a ritual song performed in worship of Dionysus (the God of Wine)
 - It is the tragedy of fate and determinism / One can't fight the gods.
 - Heroes don't have free will / Gods control man's destiny
 - Heroes have unsuspected flaw

Roman Drama was not religious and wasn't based on rituals.

Roman modelled the Greek tragedy in language, form or spirit.
